Waverly, Tenn., November 12, 2021—The Chemours Company, a global chemistry company with a manufacturing facility in New Johnsonville, today announced the expansion of its Chemours Future of Engineering, Science, Trades and Technology (ChemFEST) school partnership program to Humphreys County. Chemours Johnsonville will partner with Waverly Junior High School (WJHS) to ensure younger students are exposed to science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) education early on, especially as students remain displaced after the August flooding.

“As part of our Corporate Responsibility Commitment and 2030 goals, we are investing in our Humphreys County community to increase access to science, technology, engineering, and math skills for students of all levels,” said Plant Manager C.J. Hilton. “I’m happy we can form a good partnership through ChemFEST with Waverly Junior High School, and we look forward to working hand in hand with them to identify future opportunities.”

The ChemFEST school partnership model is customized to meet the needs of each school and local community where Chemours operates. All programs include multi-year financial support as part of Chemours’ Corporate Responsibility

Commitment goal to invest \$50 million to create and sustain vibrant communities. The time, talent, financial resources and expertise of Chemours and its employees will be used to help meet each school’s needs with the goal of engaging and inspiring the next generation of STEM professionals.

“Chemours has supported the school in the past by completing science experiments as part of the Chemours ‘Fun with Science’ program but would like to work more closely with the school to build a successful STEM program,” stated Amanda Smith, Chemours Johnsonville contract administrator.

WJHS is the largest middle school in Humphreys County whose purpose and mission is to prepare students for lifelong learning and teach them the educational skills necessary to grow into successful high school students and adults. The initial \$5,000 funding grant will provide support to WJHS for STEM activities. It is expected that additional funding will be provided as Chemours Johnsonville and WJHS collaborate to understand and fulfill specific needs and opportunities.

“What could be a better opportunity as Waverly Junior High School rebuilds,” said WJHS Principal Clayton Callicott. “We’re excited about it. This exposure is something for kids to look forward to and build a foundation for our community that Chemours is such a supporter of.”

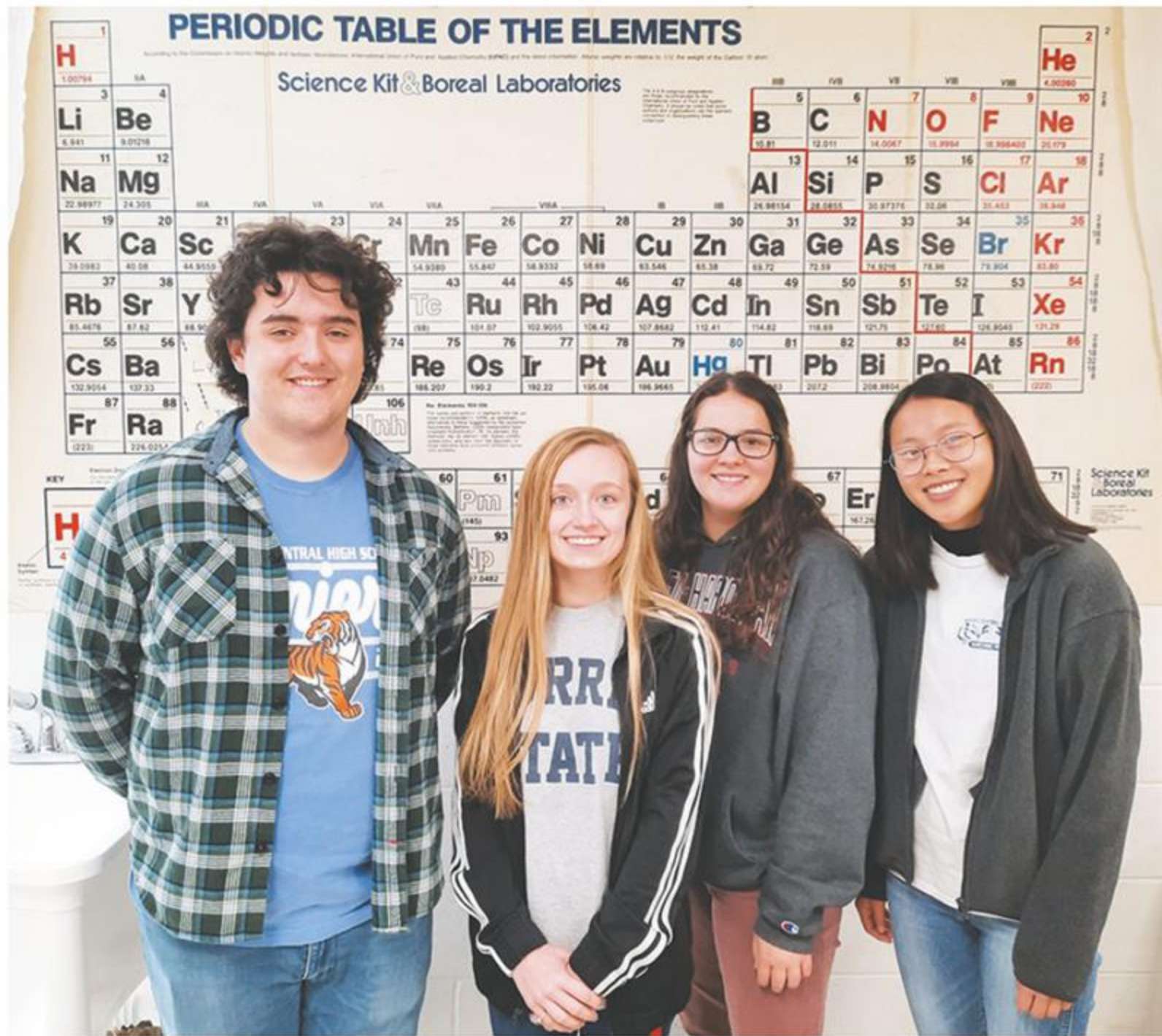
